

Modern Slavery Statement

This statement is made pursuant to s.54 of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and sets out the steps that PCWS Ltd has taken and is continuing to take to ensure that modern slavery or human trafficking is not taking place within our business or supply chain.

Modern slavery encompasses slavery, servitude, human trafficking and forced labour. PCWS has a zero tolerance approach to any form of modern slavery. We are committed to acting ethically and with integrity and transparency in all business dealings and to putting effective systems and controls in place to safeguard against any form of modern slavery taking place within the business or our supply chain.

These services include advice on best practice, collection, recovery, recycling and disposal of Hazardous and Non Hazardous Waste as well as assembly, supply and maintenance of cleaning machines for automotive and industrial applications, e.g. spray gun cleaners, parts washers and brake cleaners.

- 4. Recruitment policy. We operate a robust recruitment policy, including conducting eligibility to work in the UK, checks for all employees to safeguard against human trafficking or individuals being forced to work against their will.
- Whistle blowing policy. We operate a whistle blowing policy so that all employees know that they can raise concerns about how colleagues are being treated, or practices within our business or supply chain, without fear of reprisals.
- 6. Code of business conduct. This code explains the manner in which we behave as an organisation and how we expect our employees and suppliers to act

Due Diligence Processes

PCWS operates a supplier policy and maintains a preferred supplier list. We conduct due diligence on all suppliers before allowing them to become a preferred supplier by reviewing on a regular basis all aspects of the supply chain.

The Health, Safety and Environmental Standards for Contractors booklet provides a brief guide to the safety, health and environmental standards that the company expects of its contractors and their employees. Suppliers are required to confirm that no part of their business operations contradicts this policy.
